Code of Conduct for Student

Discipline

- The students should be aware of all the rules and regulations of our college.
- Each student shall behave in a good manner, both within and outside the campus of the College as a student of a prestigious College.
- Each student shall show due respect and courtesy towards Visitor, Principal, teachers & non teaching staff of the College.
- Lack of courtesy and decorum; unbecoming conduct within and outside the College; willful damage to College property, removal of any property belonging to the College, fellow students or other personnel of the College; use of abusive and offensive language; disturbing fellow students in their studies; breach of rules and regulations of the College; adoption of unfair practices in tests, quizzes, assignments, or examinations; noisy and unruly behavior shall constitute violation of the code of conduct.
- Loud talking, loitering or congregating, being a source of distraction and annoyance to others is not permitted.
- Students are prohibited to take part in ragging, political activity or any activity which is
 detrimental to the dignity of the College. Any students found violating the rule or bringing
 disrepute to the College will be expelled from the College.
- No responsibility will be accepted by the College for any injury, loss or damage to the personal belongings of students.
- The students will compensate damage to College property furniture caused by neglect or willful damage. Defacing the walls or College property will be viewed seriously.
- Students must pay their fees / dues on or before the prescribed deadline. The payment norms are as per NCTE, Shikshanshulk samiti and University of Pune.
- The college will organize placement focused skill enhancement programs for the students as per the need. The updates for the same will be given from time to time.

Attendance and Id- Card

• All the students must carry I-card every day to college and shall show the same on demand by any faculty official of the College.

- Late arrival and early departure at or from a class are recorded as absence from the class.
 Students are not allowed to leave the College during working hours without the written permissions of the Principal / class in charge.
- It is compulsory for the students to attend functions activities organized by the College on various occasions like Independence Day, Republic Day, Annual Day, etc.
- Candidate has to fulfill the minimum attendance requirements as per university norms.
- It may please be noted that attendance from first day is mandatory.
